

**From Fans to Followers**  
**The Gospel of Mark: Servant and Savior—Part 13**  
**Mark 3:7-19**

**We see from Mark 3:10-12 that Jesus did two main things when ministering to the crowds:**

1. He \_\_\_\_\_ many with diseases. (v. 10)
2. He \_\_\_\_\_ many with demons. (vv.11-12)

**When they [the demons] confessed who He was, He silenced them, which He did that for two reasons:**

1. There was a common belief that the knowledge of one's precise name conferred \_\_\_\_\_ over that person.
2. Christ quieted them because He didn't want or need \_\_\_\_\_ from them – He didn't want to be associated in any way with unclean spirits.

**Here's our main idea today:**

Jesus doesn't want you to be a fickle \_\_\_\_\_ but to become a faithful \_\_\_\_\_.
